#### Classes: MAXIMUM of 12 rider entries per Group

- **1.** To be ridden with 2 helpers only, 1 leading & 1 side walking.
- 2. To be ridden with 1 helpers only.
- 3. To be ridden independently (caller only) please indicate on form whether you will be jumping or not. To jump- a rider must be a member of a SJ group.
- 4. To be ridden with 3 helpers only, 1 leading and 2 side walking.

Top 2 riders in each section (junior & senior) in each class qualify. In riders of 10 or more first 3 will qualify. ALL RIDERS MUST ACHIEVE **65% OR OVER** TO QUALIFY Classes are divided into two sections – junior and senior; junior riders are those who are 16 years of age or under on 1 January 2019.

Visually impaired entrants will compete in a separate class at Hartpury for V.I. riders so please ensure you let us know if any of your riders are visually impaired so that we can ensure they are entered into the correct class.

Please note changes in the course and options available to the rider. These can be seen on the RDA National website.

Rider times will be emailed the week starting April 29<sup>th</sup> Times will also be put on the N Wales Website and Facebook

### **Conditions:**

1. Entries for national championships will be sent to Hartpury by each Group (not by the Region.)

2. Competitors must let Region know if they wish to go to Hartpury (to attend the National Championship Finals) if they have qualified, so that Region can liaise with

3. Groups and National Office as to who is eligible to enter.

4. No entries will be accepted without the entry fee either by BACs or cheque. Cheques should be made payable to 'North Wales Region RDA'.

5. Entries must be received by the closing date: April 5<sup>th</sup> All entries must be accompanied by entry fee

6. There is a maximum of 12 entries per group for the countryside challenge. It doesn't matter how it's split between classes, e.g 6 in class 1 and 6 in class 2, or 12 in one class only.

### LATE ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. Payments not made by the closing date will incur a 20% surcharge.

### ARMBANDS: In order to make people more aware, the following arm bands to be worn:

Riders with a visual impairment to wear a white armband

Riders with a hearing impairment to wear a yellow armband

Riders who do not wish to have their photo taken or appear in any photos put on social media may wear a pink armband. People taking photos of their riders or family members on the day are asked to respect other riders' rights not to be photographed and to check that riders wearing pink armbands do not appear in the background of any photos.

Ask Di Porter if you wish to borrow armbands on the day- she has organised a blue box with all the different colours in for the Qualifier day. Please ensure you return any borrowed armbands once you have ridden.
