Please note riders should be only competing in the classes that they are eligible to ride in at the RDA National Championships. Call Sara 07823 779 387 or Linda 07906 783 682 (North Wales Dressage Reps) you are not sure which class to enter.

Riders may ride more than one class at Regionals (but may only qualify for one class.)

Any Independent riders must contact Alys (telephone: 0775 2110825) to arrange to qualify.

If a riders' classification is more than 2 years old contact contact Linda 07906 783 682 or Sara 07823 779 387 for more info Non classified (ungraded) riders may enter in the Grade 1-6 class. Any non graded riders with learning disabilities must enter I/D classes.

The first two riders in each class will qualify, if they gain a minimum 60% mark. In classes of more than 10 then the first 3 riders will qualify.

Entries will be sent to Hartpury by each Group not by the Region. Competitors must let Region know if they wish to go to Hartpury (to attend the National Championship Finals) if they have qualified, so that Region can liaise with Groups and National Office as to who is eligible to enter.

This competition will be run under RDA dressage rules. Tests may be called. Entries must be received by the closing date. All entries must be accompanied by entry fee **LATE ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. Payments not made by the closing date will incur a 20% surcharge.** Rider qualifier times will be available starting 29<sup>th</sup> April by email
