Conditions:

- 1. Entries for national championships will be sent to Hartpury by each Group (not by the Region.)
- 2. Competitors must let Region know if they wish to go to Hartpury (to attend the National Championship Finals) if they have qualified, so that Region can liaise with Groups and National Office as to who is eligible to enter.
- 4. No entries will be accepted without the entry fee either by BACs or cheque. Cheques should be made payable to 'North Wales Region RDA'.
- 5. Entries must be received by the closing date: April 5th All entries must be accompanied by entry fee
- 6. All horses must be fully inoculated and have passports with them at the competition
- 7. All horses must have been assessed as suitable for RDA Show Jumping prior to the event. This may have been done by your Group but if you are using your own horse it will need to have been seen by our Show Jumping Rep Kirstie Harper, or by a member of the Show Jumping Committee before the competition.
